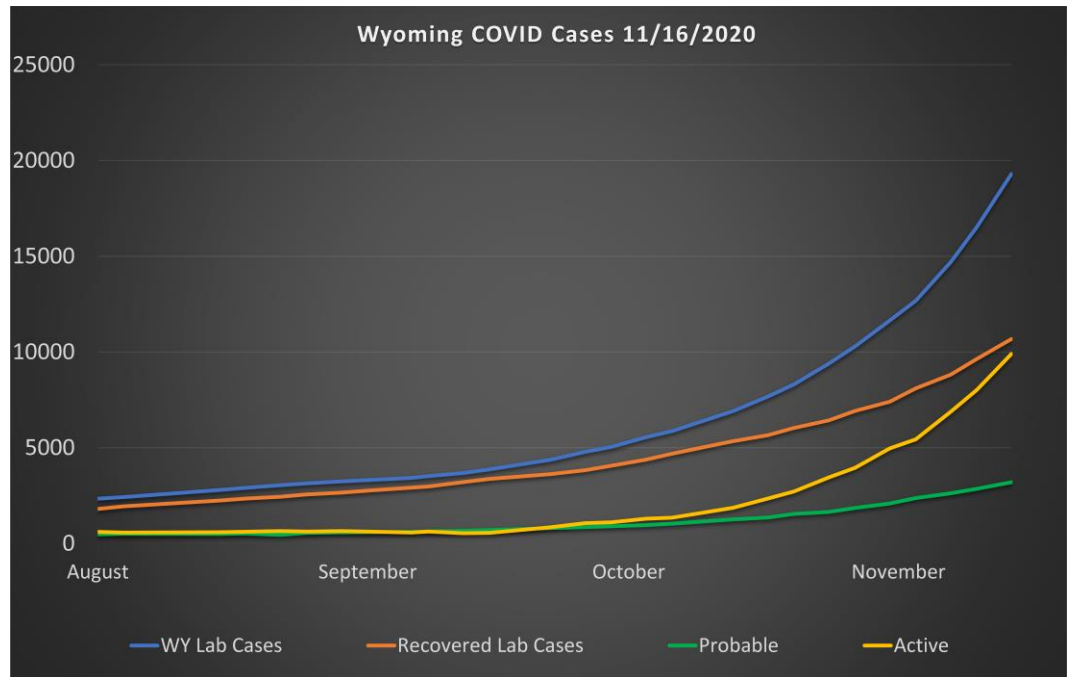

### COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- Fever
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
