Washakie County Residents and Businesses:

CodeRED has upgraded the database to support members of Washakie County, if signing up for a neighboring county, please register through their website or contact their Emergency Management Coordinator/Director, if required. I opt into their systems, in the event that near border assistance is required, in mutual aid and in being a good neighbor responder.

CodeRED will run in alignment with Rapid Notify (no changes there): sending same message. Both systems are software programs in mass notification to support crisis and emergency alerts. CodeRED is being reborn and tested to enhance the capabilities of Public Health, Fire, Hazardous Materials, Emergency Management and Homeland Security initiatives with optimization of the latest technology, such as gas plume modeling scenarios.

At present the CodeRED data base is loaded with information from the white pages, yellow pages and needs the unique profile that you select in cellphones, emails or other pertinent contact information. It is at no cost, free, secure and easily updated initially or in the future, should you need a change in update, to edit. Please share with others!

Instructions are two-fold:

Part I: Customize your secure profile in the CodeRED database, update relevant contact(s)

Part II: Launch your CodeRED App (IOS or Android) to be covered in US, Canada or Caribbean

Click on:  CodeRED™

The link is embedded in the logo and the account page will show, to initiate your own profile:

Enter Name in: First Last, in separate box (or business name)

Click on: Residential or Business

Enter phone number: (use full 10 digit number, no spaces/ no dashes)

Check box, if desired: TDD/TTV Device

Check box, for send a text: (no cost to receive text messages by your provider)

Provider: (pull down menu: 8 down is Verizon Wireless, example)

*texts could be all severe weather warnings, relevant to our area: free, no cost

+ Add Phone: Potential to add cellphone, work, friend, family

+Add Email: 1 or more: work, family, personal, neighbor, etc.

Account information: will seek an email for confirmation.

Data Privacy: may click on the box, (My Information Private)

Check box: Terms & Conditions

Click on bottom, right box: Verification

*note: Any missing fields will prompt you to apply, may have to move balloon icon on map

Verify your account settings: Hit Continue button
